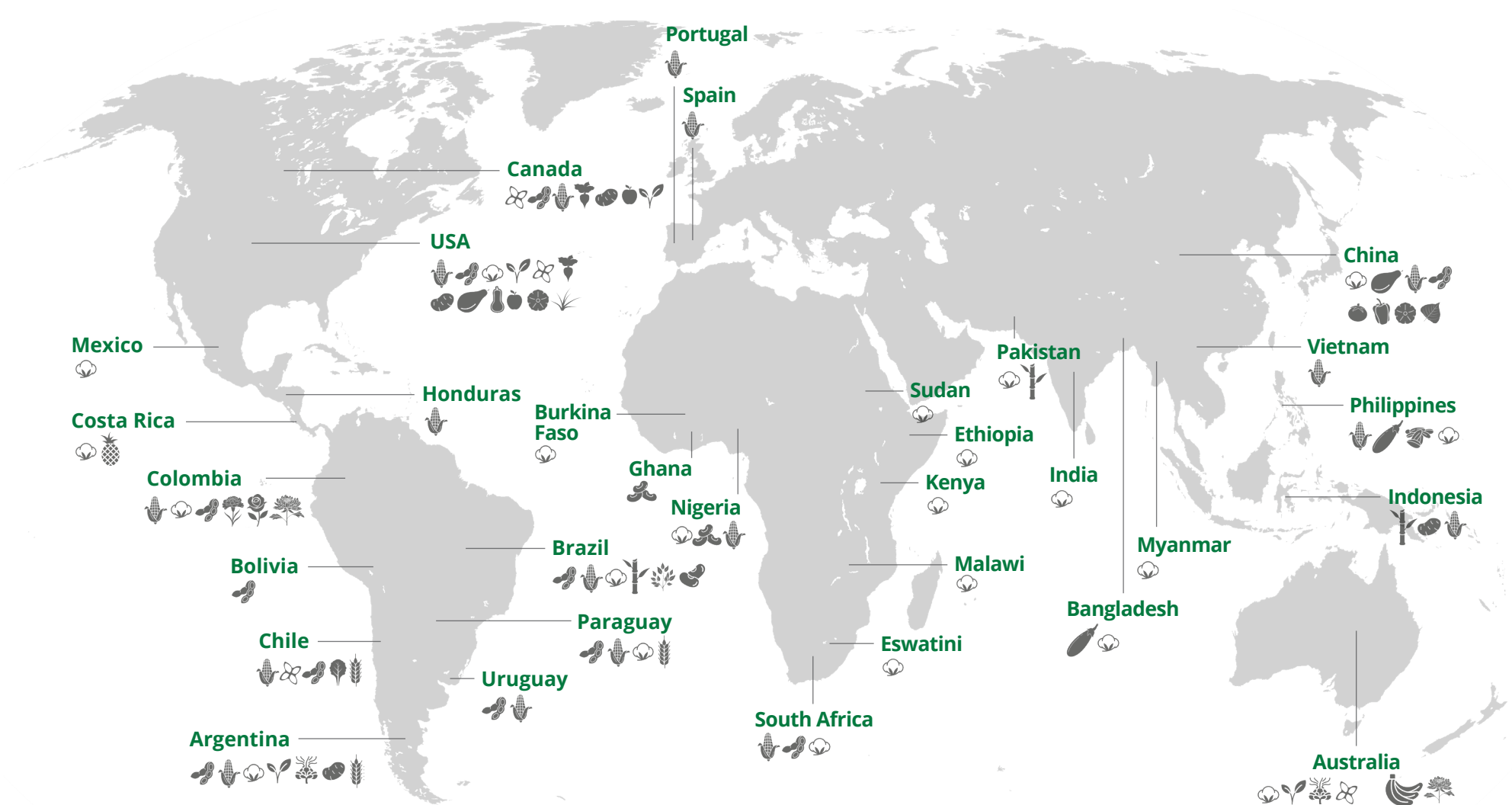


COUNTRIES APPROVING GM CROP CULTIVATION
