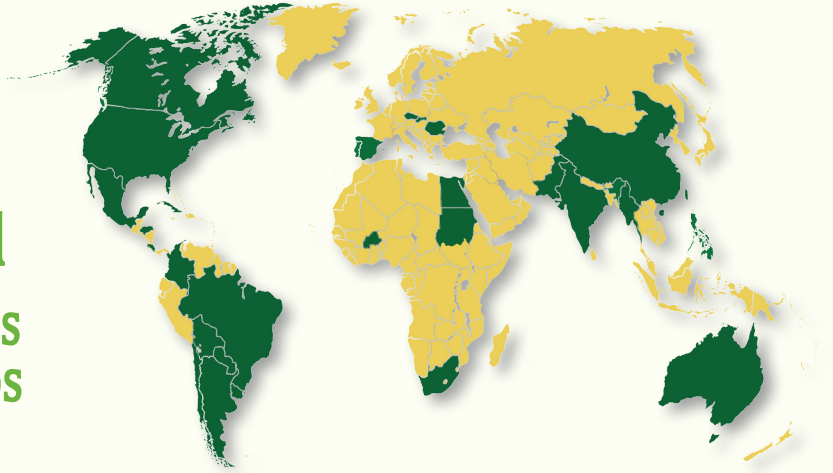
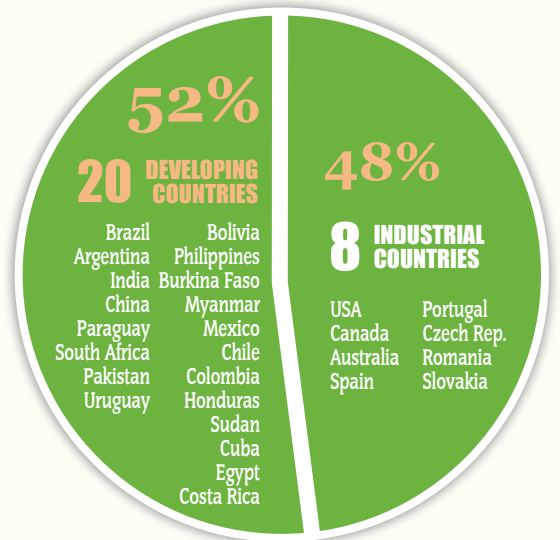
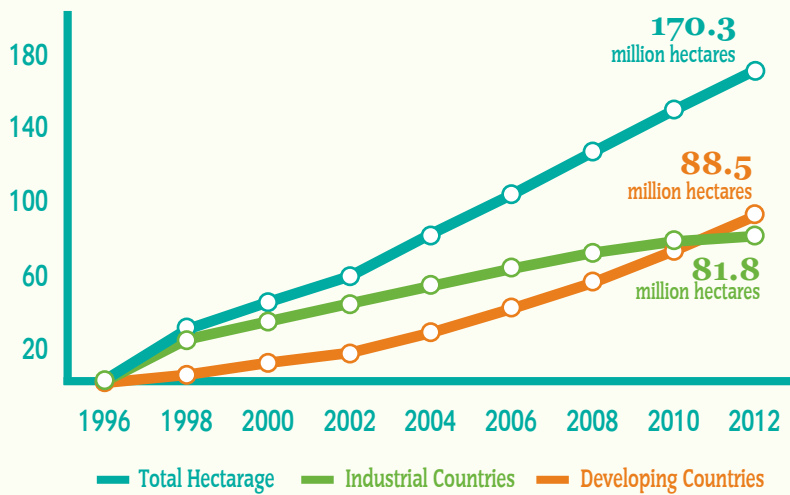


Global Status of Commercialized Biotech/GM Crops in 2012

For the first time, developing countries grew more biotech crops than industrial countries.
